IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

- All artists must complete the **Participation Agreement** before receiving a canvas.
- All artwork must be original and fit within the 6" x 6" canvas provided.
- Individuals may work independently or as a team.
- 3-D artwork is permitted provided the 3-D component protrudes from the face of the canvas only. Canvases will be fastened together tightly on all sides to create the mosaic with Velcro so please avoid making your canvas too heavy to hold.
- The Hardy reserves the right to reject any artwork it deems inappropriate for display.
- As a community project, we warmly welcome participation from artists of all ages. Please encourage children to create works worthy of display at a professional gallery.
- Each artist must complete and submit an **Artist Statement Form** with their completed canvas (distributed with the canvas; this form can also be downloaded at www.thehardy.org).
- Hanging and arranging the individual works will be at the discretion of the Hardy Gallery. Important: Please remember to let us know the correct orientation for your work so it gets hung properly!
- Each canvas will be donated to the Hardy and therefore becomes the property of the nonprofit organization. However, each artist retains the copyright to his/her artwork if properly marked with the copyright © next to the artist's signature.
- After **August 25**, canvases will be packaged and shipped to patrons. The Hardy Gallery is unable to make any exchanges on canvases.
